Publicly Funded Family Planning Clinics Prevent 1.4 Million Unintended Pregnancies & Save \$4.3 Billion in Public Funds
Publicly funded family planning clinics provide contraceptive services to approximately seven million women each year. **1.4 million unintended pregnancies and 600,000 abortions are averted each year because of these services.** Twenty percent of the pregnancies averted would occur among teenagers. In the absence of publicly funded services, there would be nearly 50% more teen pregnancies (or 290,000 more); these additional pregnancies would result in about 150,000 unplanned births and 100,000 abortions.
