The 2006 Kids Count Databook has been released. The good news is, the report shows that Missouri improved on seven of the ten outcome measures while "backsliding" on three. Showing improvement were measures of births to mothers with less than 12 years of education, child deaths, child abuse/neglect, out-of-home placements, high school dropouts, births to teens, and teen violent deaths.
