Membership with the Partnership means *more* opportunities to collaborate with other agencies, *more* "best practices" programs, *more* resource information, and *more* updates on current issues; all used toward preventing teen pregnancy throughout the St. Louis city and county areas. There are 2 different types of memberships:

- **Organization Members: annual membership fee is \$100**
(\$50 for organizations with annual budgets of \$250,000 or less, with documentation)
Up to 4 staff members are included; additional staff can be added for \$10 each.
- **Individual Members: annual membership fee is \$25**

Teen pregnancy affects us all, individually, as a community, and as a nation. The United States has the highest rate of teen pregnancy in the industrialized world. In St. Louis City, 17.7% of births are to teenage mothers, and the rate of sexually transmitted diseases in teens is among the highest in the nation. Join us in our mission to help prevent teen pregnancy and diseases by improving communication, education, and policies; staying informed; getting involved and raising awareness.
